



### Vertical Sculptural Marker

- Placed at longer intervals, every mile or more, or where a larger marker would be more important ie. parks.
- 5 - 6' feet tall
- Wood, bronze or steel



### Medallion Marker

- Placed every quartermile
- 12 - 15" inches in diameter
- Cast Bronze with custom patina and abalone inlay




### Other animals could be used to create variation across 8-10 medallion markers:

- bear: xus
- dolphin: 'alolk'oy
- bobcat: 'anaqpuw
- starfish: 'elewese
- butterfly: 'ayatulutul
- rabbit: qun
- fish: alimu

### Variations Of Medallion

- communicate convergence and divergence of trails by addition or removal of logos



\*If color is desired that can be achieved through patination or painting of metal
